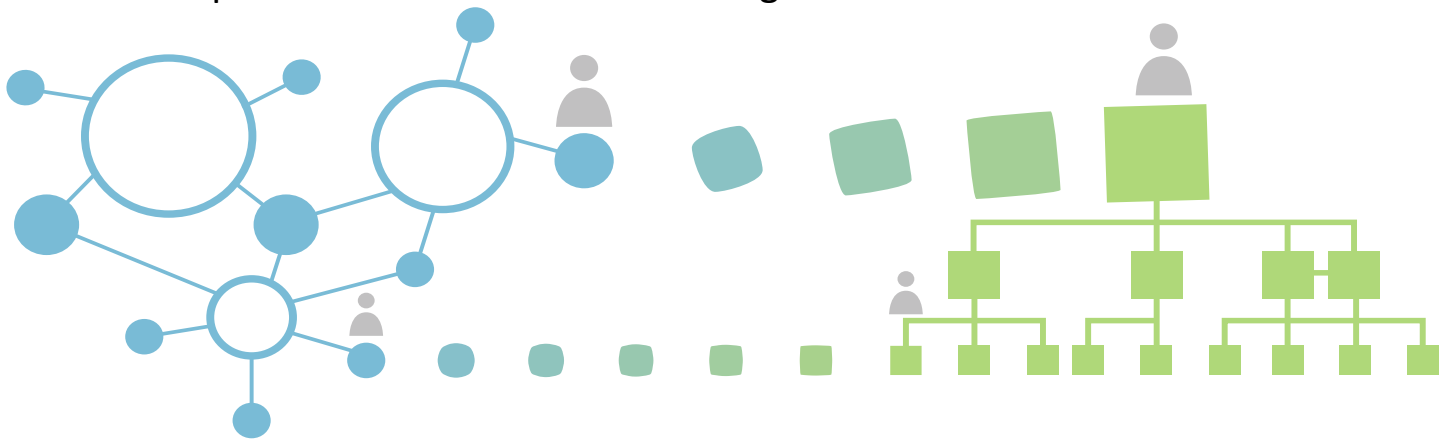

THE LEADERSHIP LAB

Attendees to the November 2017 offering can opt to participate in the companion Leadership Lab for 6 months following the course residential at no additional charge. Through the Leadership Lab, participants define their own “fieldwork experiment”, developed and framed by the course concepts, to conduct in their respective organizations. Leadership Lab participants are placed in small groups to engage in regular, meaningful thought-partnership around the development of each participant’s experiment. Participants convene virtually to share updates on their progress along with lessons learned from the applied experience. While participation in the Leadership Lab is optional, it is a highly-suggested way to continue the learning journey with your new network.
